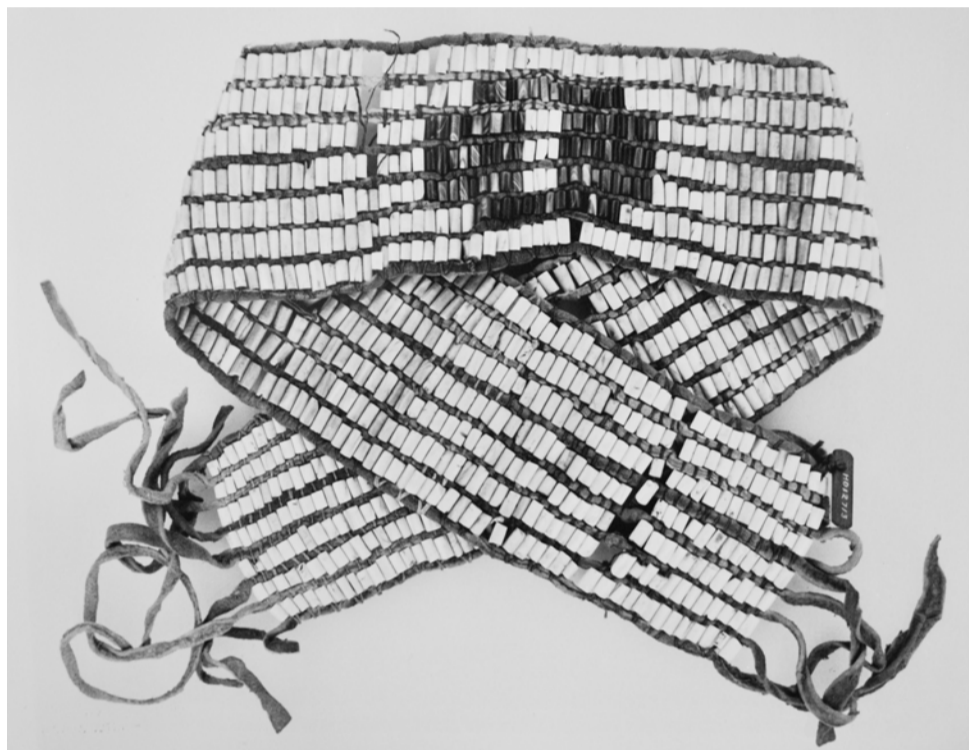


First Law of the Land: Sharing from the Great Dish
